## ~ Resolution 2020 – 141 ~

### RESOLUTION BY THE TOWNSHIP OF WEST MILFORD, COUNTY OF PASSAIC, STATE OF NEW JERSEY TO AUTHORIZE THE PAYMENT OF RE-OCCURRING EXPENDITURES BY THE TOWNSHIP BUSINESS ADMINISTRATOR IN THE EVENT OF THE CANCELLATION OF A REGULARLY SCHEDULED MEETING IN 2020

**WHEREAS**, Governor Murphy, on March 9, 2020, issued Executive Order No. 103, declaring a State of Emergency pursuant to N.J.S.A. App.A.:9-33 et seq. and a Public Health Emergency as contemplated by N.J.S.A. 26:13-1 et seq. within the State of New Jersey, effective immediately until further notice by the Governor that an emergency no longer exists; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township of West Milford is undertaking the necessary steps to insure the continued functioning of government and the allocation of resources on an emergent basis; and

**WHEREAS**, in the event the regularly scheduled meetings of the Governing Body are canceled, government must be prepared to continue to proceed with necessary services and payment of certain expenditures; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township Business Administrator is the highest ranking full-time official of the Township and Chief Operating Officer of the municipality.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Mayor and Township Council of the Township of West Milford, County of Passaic and State of New Jersey as follows:

1. The Mayor and Township Council hereby authorize William Senande, Township Business Administrator to disburse and/or authorize payment, subject to the availability of funds, for re-occurring necessary expenses in the event that the Mayor and Township Council cancel a regularly scheduled meeting of the Governing Body.
2. Those disbursements that are made by Mr. Senande will be placed on a subsequent meeting bill list for full disclosure to the public and the Township Council of the expenditures authorized by Mr. Senande under such circumstances.

This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
