### RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WEST MILFORD, COUNTY OF PASSAIC, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AUTHORIZING THE USE OF SERVICES FROM US SPORTS INSTITUTE INC. IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE PAY-TO-PLAY LAW N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.5

**WHEREAS**, the Township of West Milford has been providing multi sports programs for the youth of West Milford using US Sports Institute Inc.; and

**WHEREAS**, due to the popularity of these programs the Recreation Department is approaching the \$17,500 threshold; and

**WHEREAS**, the Recreation Department reached out to other vendors that offer similar programs however three (3) quotes obtained were “no quotes” as per the non-fair and open contract pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.5; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township of West Milford Council has requested that any purchase over \$17,500 be approved by Council; and

**WHEREAS**, US Sports Institute Inc. will comply with state pay-to-play regulation by completing and submitting a Business Entity Disclosure Certification which certifies that the firm has not made any reportable contributions to a political or candidate committee in the Township of West Milford with the elected officials in the previous one year, and that US Sports Institute Inc. will not make any reportable contributions through the remainder of the year; and

**WHEREAS**, the Chief Financial Officer has certified as to the availability of funds to be encumbered from account number 01-201-28-370-687; and

**WHEREAS**, US Sports Institute Inc. will exceed the \$17,500 and should not exceed the bid threshold of \$40,000.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Council of the Township of West Milford, County of Passaic, State of New Jersey that US Sports Institute Inc. is hereby authorized and approved as the provided three (3) no quotes were obtained and total purchases not to exceed \$40,000.
