RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WEST MILFORD, COUNTY OF PASSAIC, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AUTHORIZING THE RENEWAL OF INACTIVE PLENARY RETAIL CONSUMPTION LICENSE NO 1615-33-011-003 PETER W. ANOLL FOR THE 2010 - 2011 LICENSE YEAR WITH CONDITIONS

WHEREAS, an application for renewal of Plenary Retail Consumption License No. 1615-33-011-003 Peter W. Anoll for the 2010 - 2011 License year has been received and reviewed; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Township Council has conducted a public review of the application as stipulated in the guidelines of the Director of the Division of Alcoholic Beverage Control dated April 14, 1980; and

WHEREAS, as a result of that review the Township Council has determined as follows:

1. The submitted application is complete in all respects.
2. The applicant is qualified to be licensed according to all statutory, regulatory and local governmental A.B.C. laws and regulations.
3. The applicant has disclosed to the issuing authority the source of all additional financing obtained in the previous license year (July 1, 2009 - June 30, 2010).
4. The applicant has received a Special Ruling from the Director of the NJ Division of Alcoholic Beverage Control.
5. Recommendations have been received in the Office of the Township Clerk from all applicable departments, with conditions.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Township Clerk is directed to issue and hold the license certificate for the Mayor and Township Council of the Township of West Milford with conditions as follows:

Premise must be inspected and approved by the Police Department prior to opening and activation of the license. 2. Licensee must apply for and receive a Food Handler License, and premise must be inspected and approved by the Health Department prior to opening and activation of the license. 3. Premise must be inspected and approved by the Fire Marshall prior to opening and activation of the license. 4. Licensee must submit applicable pages of 12 page application for activation to the Township Clerk within ten days prior or following opening premises. 5. Licensee must file a 12.39 Petition with the Director of the NJ ABC for license renewals until premise is opened and license activated.
