RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WEST MILFORD, COUNTY OF PASSAIC, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AUTHORIZING A DEVIATION FROM §500-36.1.D(2) OF THE TOWNSHIP CODE SO THAT THE FARMER'S MARKET CAN OPERATE FOR A 20-WEEK PERIOD FROM MID-MAY TO MID-OCTOBER 2013

WHEREAS, section §500-36.1.D(2) of the Township code authorizes the operation of an annual farmer's market, with the appropriate permits, from June 1 through October 31 of each calendar year; and

WHEREAS, a request has been made to modify this requirement so that the market can operate from mid-May to mid-October each year which is consistent with the availability of fresh food and produce; and

WHEREAS, the Township Council is considering such permanent amendment to said schedule by virtue of amending the code accordingly; and

WHEREAS, to afford the organizers time to prepare for the 2013 season, a resolution is necessary to convey authorization from the Council for this year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Council of the Township of West Milford that they do hereby authorize those staff members who issue permits in accordance with §500-36 of the Township code to issue such permits for a 20-week period from mid-May to mid-October, 2013.
