RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WEST MILFORD, COUNTY OF PASSAIC, STATE OF NEW JERSEY REQUESTING CHANGE IN TITLE, TEXT, OR AMOUNT OF APPROPRIATION

WHEREAS, N.J.S.A. 40A:4-85 provides that the Director of the Division of Local Government Services may, at the request of, or with the consent of, the governing body of any county or municipality, make such correction of the title, text, or amount of any appropriation appearing in the budget as may be necessary to make said item of appropriation available for the purpose or purposes required for the needs of any county or municipality.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that in accordance with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40a:4-85 THE Township of West Milford hereby requests the Director of the Division of Local Government Services to make the following correction in the 2013 budget:

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the foregoing correction is in the opinion of the governing body, warranted and authorized by the statute referred to above, and is necessary for the orderly operation of the Township of West Milford for the reasons set forth:

The change is being requested because the Township was awarded the 2013 ROID grant after the Township's 2013 budget was adopted therefore, appropriations need to be moved from the grants matching funds to the local share for the ROID grant.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Township Clerk forward two copies of this resolution to the Director of Local Government Services.
