## **RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WEST MILFORD, COUNTY OF PASSAIC, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH THE GREENWOOD LAKE BI-STATE COMMISSION TO ACCEPT WEEDHARVESTING EQUIPMENT**

**WHEREAS**, Greenwood Lake is a public access body of water located in both New Jersey and New York; and

**WHEREAS**, the Greenwood Lake Bi-State Commission is a public agency created to foster the economic and environmental quality of Greenwood Lake including but not limited to periodic harvesting of aquatic weeds; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township of West Milford has agreed to assume some of the lake maintenance activities of the Commission for that portion of the lake in the Township, specifically periodic weed harvesting activities; and

**WHEREAS**, the Greenwood Lake Commission has ownership of various pieces of equipment to harvest weeds growing in the lake and to facilitate the Township's weedharvesting efforts has agreed to transfer ownership of certain pieces of weedharvesting equipment to the Township of West Milford.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Township Council of the Township of West Milford that the Township of West Milford does hereby accept the terms and conditions for the transfer of ownership of certain weedharvesting equipment as set forth in the Agreement which shall remain on file in the Office of the Township Clerk.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Mayor and Township Clerk be and are hereby authorized to execute said agreement on behalf of the Township and to forward said executed Agreement to the appropriate parties at the Lake Commission and other involved agencies and parties.
