**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WEST MILFORD, COUNTY OF PASSAIC, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AUTHORIZING THE PERSON-TO-PERSON TRANSFER OF PLENARY RETAIL CONSUMPTION LICENSE NO. 1615-33-027-010 FROM NORMTRA, LLC TO BENNETT, TRACEY A. FOR PREMISES AT THE SAME LOCATION**

**WHEREAS**, an application for the person to person transfer of Plenary Retail Consumption License 1615-33-027-010 – Normtra, LLC to Bennett, Tracey A. for premises at the same location has been received and reviewed; and

**WHEREAS**, the Mayor and Township Council has conducted a public review of the application as stipulated in the guidelines of the Director of the Division of Alcoholic Beverage Control; and

**WHEREAS**, as a result of that review the Mayor and Township Council have determined as follows:

1. The submitted application is complete in all respects.
2. The applicant is qualified to be licensed according to all statutory, regulatory and local governmental A.B.C. laws and regulations.
3. The applicant has disclosed to the issuing authority the source of all additional financing obtained in the previous license year (July 1, 2013 - June 30, 2014).

**WHEREAS**, the Police Department has recommended that the license be transferred with conditions;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the transfer application is hereby approved and the Township Clerk is authorized to endorse the transfer and deliver the license certificate for the Mayor and Township Council of the Township of West Milford.

Patrons are not to leave the curtilage of the licensed premises with alcoholic beverages.<br>2. The licensed portion of the deck must have a railing and gate which physically separates it from non-licensed areas.<br>3. A written notice must also be posted instructing patrons that they cannot leave the licensed portion of the premises with alcoholic beverages.<br>4. Amplified music should be restricted to the interior of the building only. This should include live bands and DJ's.<br>5. Non-amplified musical entertainment outside the building should remain within the licensed area and cease by 9:00 pm |
