RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WEST MILFORD, COUNTY OF PASSAIC, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AUTHORIZING CHANGE ORDER NO. 1 TO THE CONTRACT FOR THE PURCHASE OF ROCK SALT FROM CARGILL INCORPORATED DEICING TECHNOLOGY

WHEREAS, the Department of Public Works has found it necessary to request a change order to the contract with Cargill Incorporated Deicing Technology, 24950 Country Club Blvd., Suite 450, North Olmsted, Ohio 44070.

WHEREAS, due to the number and type of storms this season there is a need to amend our contract for the purchase of salt in order to be prepared for the remainder of this season. A change order in the amount of \$100,000 for the purchase of up to 1600 tons of rock salt at the current contract price of \$62.49 per ton is requested. This amount is less than 20% of the original contract amount of \$531,165.00.

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has certified as to the availability of funds and encumbrances for this purchase shall come from account number 01-26-294-363; and

WHEREAS, after careful consideration the Governing Body has found it to be in the best interest of the Township to award a change order to the contract to Cargill Incorporated Deicing Technology.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council of the Township of West Milford, County of Passaic, State of New Jersey, the following:

1. The Township Council hereby awards a change order to the contract to Cargill Incorporated Deicing Technology for Rock Salt in an amount not to exceed \$100,000.00.
2. The Township Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to execute a change order with Cargill Incorporated Deicing Technology in accordance with its bid for Rock Salt.
3. The Township's Chief Financial Officer has certified the availability of fund for same.
4. This resolution, change order and contract shall be available for public inspection in the office of the Municipal Clerk.
