**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WEST MILFORD, COUNTY OF PASSAIC AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF ONE (1) 2016 JOHN DEERE 60G COMPACT EXCAVATOR THROUGH MRESC CO-OP (MIDDLESEX REGIONAL EDUCATIONAL SERVICES COMMISSION) 65MCECCPS BID # MRESC 15/16-08**

**WHEREAS**, the Township of West Milford became a member of the MRESC by virtue of Resolution 2015-311 adopted October 7, 2015; and

**WHEREAS**, effective March 2, 2016 MRESC's name change to "The Educational Services Commission of New Jersey" was unanimously approved by the New Jersey State Board of Education; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township wishes to purchase a 2016 John Deere 60G Compact Excavator; and

**WHEREAS**, the Director of Public Works and the Supervising Mechanic have provided a recommendation to award this contract through MRESC CO-OP Contract 65MCECCPS BID # MRESC 15/16-08 through John Deere Construction Industrial & Utility Equipment Retail Sales; and

**WHEREAS**, the Chief Financial Officer has certified as to the availability of funds for this purchase, said funds to be encumbered from account number 04-215-55-826-003 in the amount of \$78,221.91; and

**WHEREAS**, the total amount of the purchase shall not exceed \$78,221.91;

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Council of the Township of West Milford, County of Passaic, State of New Jersey, the following:

1. The Township Council hereby authorizes the Department of Public Works to purchase one (1) 2016 John Deere 60G Compact Excavator, in an amount not to exceed \$78,221.91, through MRESC CO-OP Contract 65MCECCPS BID # MRESC15/16-08 through John Deere Construction Industrial & Utility Equipment Retail Sales
2. The Township's Acting Chief Financial Officer has certified the availability of funds for same.
