RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WEST MILFORD, COUNTY OF PASSAIC AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING THE PURCHASE THROUGH THE MORRIS COUNTY CO-OP CONTRACT #15-A; ITEM #5 TO THREE (3) 2017 POLICE INTERCEPTOR UTILITY VEHICLES FROM BEYER FORD AND AUTHORIZE ONE (1) 2017 POLICE INTERCEPTOR SEDAN AWD VEHICLE THROUGH THE MORRIS COUNTY CO-OP CONTRACT #15-A; ITEM #1 FROM BEYER FORD

WHEREAS, the Township of West Milford adopted Resolution 2016-194 on May 18, 2016 to purchase four (4) 2017 Police Interceptor Utility vehicles and one (1) Chevrolet Tahoe; and

WHEREAS, Township Chief of Police wishes to eliminate (1) 2017 Police Interceptor Utility vehicle; and

WHEREAS, Township Chief of Police wishes to add and authorize the purchase of one (1) 2017 Police Interceptor Sedan AWD through the Morris County Co-op #15A, Item #1, base price \$24,511.00 with options of \$414.75 for a total of \$24,925.75 from Beyer Ford; and

WHEREAS, The Township Chief of Police has provided a recommendation to award this contract through the Morris County Co-op #15A; Item #1 to Beyer Ford and through the Morris County Co-op #15A for the Police Interceptor Sedan AWD; and

WHEREAS, the total amount of the contracts shall not exceed \$139,113.50.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Township of West Milford, County of Passaic and State of New Jersey as follows:

1. The Township Council hereby authorizes the Township Chief of Police to amend purchase to three (3) 2017 Police Interceptor Utility vehicles, in an amount not to exceed \$78,012.75, through Morris County Co-op #15A; Item #5 from Beyer Ford, 170 Ridgedale Avenue, Morristown, NJ 07960-4000; one (1) 2016 Chevrolet Tahoe Police Pursuit Vehicle in an amount not to exceed \$36,175.00 through Morris County Co-op #15A; Item #11 to Day Chevrolet, 1600 Golden Mile Hwy, Monroeville, PA 15146 and one (1) 2017 Police Interceptor Sedan AWD through Morris County CO-op #15A, Item #1 from Beyer Ford not to exceed \$24,925.75.
2. The Township's Acting Chief Financial Officer has certified the availability of funds for same.
3. The equipment and changeovers for three (3) 2017 Police Interceptor Utility Vehicles, one (1) 2016 Chevrolet Tahoe Police Pursuit Vehicle and one (1) 2017 Police Interceptor Sedan AWD will be submitted by future resolution.
