RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WEST MILFORD, COUNTY OF PASSAIC AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY PROVIDING ADVICE & CONSENT TO THE MAYOR'S APPOINTMENT OF CHARLES FERRAIOLI AS MUNICIPAL AUDITOR WITH COUNCIL CONSENT IN ACCORDANCE WITH SECTION §15-117 OF THE TOWNSHIP CODE AND AUTHORIZING THE AWARD OF A NON-FAIR AND OPEN PROFESSIONAL SERVICE CONTRACT FOR SAME

WHEREAS, the Township of West Milford has a need to appoint a Township Auditor as a non-fair and open contract pursuant to the provisions of *N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.4 or 20.5 as appropriate*; and,

WHEREAS, the Local Public Contracts Law (N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1, et. seq.) requires that the Resolution authorizing the award of contracts for Professional Services without competitive bids and the contract itself must be available for public inspection, and,

WHEREAS, Charles Ferraioli of the firm Ferraioli, Wielkotz, Cerullo & Cuva, P.A. will provide auditing services in accordance with their proposal dated December 22, 2017; and

WHEREAS, Charles Ferraioli has completed and submitted a Business Entity Disclosure Certification which certifies that the firm has not made any reportable contributions to a political or candidate committee in the Township of West Milford with the elected officials in the previous one year, and that the contract will prohibit the firm of Ferraioli, Wielkotz, Cerullo & Cuva, P.A. from making any reportable contributions through the term of the contract; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has certified as to the availability of funds pursuant to *N.J.A.C. 5:30-5.4*

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Council of the Township of West Milford that they do hereby concur with the Mayor's appointment of Charles Ferraioli to the position of Municipal Auditor in accordance with section §15-117 of the Township Code for a term of one year.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor and Township Council of the Township of West Milford, County of Passaic, State of New Jersey authorizes the Mayor and the Municipal Clerk to enter into a contract with Ferraioli, Wielkotz, Cerullo & Cuva, P.A. as described herein; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the contract, resolution and all other pertinent documents shall remain on file in the office of the Township Clerk; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a notice of this action shall be printed once in the Township's legal newspaper.
