RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WEST MILFORD, COUNTY OF PASSAIC AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY AUTHORIZING THE SUBMITTAL AND ACCEPTANCE OF A HIGHLANDS COUNCIL ENVIRONMENTAL AND ECONOMIC SUSTAINABILITY GRANT

WHEREAS, the Township of West Milford is located 100% within the Highlands Preservation Area; and

WHEREAS, the Highlands Council has identified certain grant opportunities for municipalities within the Highlands Area; and

WHEREAS, such a grant opportunity exists to complete a *Sustainable Economic Development Plan* which plan could:

1. Develop ideas with local residents, leaders and business owners;
2. Create a demographic analysis of the Township's population and employment;
3. Create an inventory of resources located within the Township;
4. Identify potential areas for redevelopment;
5. Conduct an analysis of current business conditions and project future business potential in the Township;
6. Generate an implementation schedule to guide and track proposed economic initiatives.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor and the Township Council of the Township of West Milford hereby authorize the submission and acceptance of a Highlands Council Environmental and Economic Sustainability Grant to Complete a Sustainable Economic Development Plan for the Township of West Milford in conformance with the Highlands Regional Master Plan.
