RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WEST MILFORD, COUNTY OF PASSAIC AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY AUTHORIZING AN INCREASE FOR THE PURCHASE OF TRAFFIC STRIPING FOR TOWNSHIP ROADWAYS THROUGH THE MORRIS COUNTY COOPERATIVE PRICING COUNCIL, CONTRACT #36 (TRAFFIC STRIPING ON ROADS) TO DENVILLE LINE PAINTING, INC. IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED AN ADDITIONAL \$3,445.41

WHEREAS, the Township of West Milford is a member of the Morris County Cooperative Pricing Council (State ID # 6-MCCoOp); and

WHEREAS, the Morris County Cooperative Pricing Council has awarded Contract #36, Traffic Striping on Roadways to Denville Line Painting, Inc.

WHEREAS, said contract was awarded through the open competitive bidding process and in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:11 et seq., Local Public Contracts Law; and

WHEREAS, the Township of West Milford previously authorized purchases through Denville Line Painting Inc., in the amount of \$120,000 by virtue of Resolution 2019-160 and in order to meet State requirements for reflectivity, additional striping in the amount of \$3,445.41 was required; and

WHEREAS, the Director of Public Works has confirmed the need for the additional striping therefore increasing the services purchased through Denville Line Painting, Inc. for the additional line striping in the amount of \$3,445.41 which represents a 2.9% increase for these purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer has certified as to the availability of funds for this additional purchase, said funds to be encumbered from account number 01-201-26-290-200;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Township of West Milford, County of Passaic, State of New Jersey, the following:

1. The Township Council hereby authorizes an additional \$3,445.41 to be expended through the Morris County Cooperative Pricing Council, contract #36, to Denville Line Painting, Inc. 2 Green Pond Road, Rockaway, NJ 07866 for the purchase of additional line striping thereby increasing the not to exceed amount for these purchases from \$120,000.00 to \$123,445.41
2. The Township's Chief Financial Officer has certified the availability of funds for same.
3. This resolution shall be available for public inspection in the office of the Township Clerk.
