RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WEST MILFORD, COUNTY OF PASSAIC, STATE OF NEW JERSEY REJECTING BIDS FOR THE COLLECTION OF RESIDENTIAL SOLID WASTE AND RECYCLABLES AND AUTHORIZING A REBID FOR THESE SERVICES

WHEREAS, the Township of West Milford solicited bids on October 2, 2019 at 10:00 a.m. for the Collection of Residential Solid Waste and Recyclables; and

WHEREAS, in response to the “Notice to Bidders” four obtained the bid specifications but only one firm bid for the contract; and

WHEREAS, said bid has been duly reviewed by the Township Administrator who recommends that the bid be rejected and the contract be rebid due to the bid substantially exceeding the Township’s appropriation for the services and to the absence of competitive bids received for the services and the sole bid represented a significant increase in Township budget costs; and

WHEREAS, the Local Public Contracts Law, specifically N.J.S.A. §40A:11-13.2 authorizes a municipality to reject all bids; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the Township of West Milford, County of Passaic, State of New Jersey, that the bids received on October 2, 2019 for the Collection of Residential Solid Waste and Recyclables is hereby rejected and the Township Administrator is authorized to rebid this contract soon as possible within the time constraints provided in state law.
