RESOLUTION OF THE TOWSHIP OF WEST MILFORD, COUNTY OF PASSAIC, STATE OF NEW JERSEY RE-ESTABLISHING A TOWNSHIP STORMWATER POLLUTION PREVENTION TEAM

WHEREAS, the State of New Jersey requires the re-establishment of a Stormwater Pollution Prevention Team to assist in the development of regulations by the Township in conformance with requirements of the State's Stormwater pollution Prevention Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Township Council of the Township of West Milford that it does hereby re-establish a Stormwater Pollution Prevention Team (number of team members may vary) as follows:

Purpose: to prepare an assessment of the infrastructure improvements that would be necessary to the Township's Stormwater facilities and to also develop a plan to maintain these facilities in accordance with state regulations.

Membership: The Committee shall consist of seven (7) members including:

- 1) Director of Public Works, Program Coordinator
- 2) Township Clerk, Public Notice Coordinator
- Construction Official, Post Construction Stormwater Management Coordinator & Ordinance Coordinator
- 4) Environmental Commission Chairman, Local Public Education Coordinator
- 5) Director of Public Works, Public Works Coordinator
- 6) Health Officer, Illicit Connection Coordinator
- 7) GIS Specialist, Mapping Coordinator
