## ~ Resolution 2012 – 301

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WEST MILFORD, COUNTY OF PASSAIC, STATE OF NEW JERSEY PROVIDING CONSENT TO A PROJECT AT BLOCK 5708, LOT 4, 54 MARSHALL HILL ROAD IN THE TOWNSHIP OF WEST MILFORD WHICH REQUIRES A TREATMENT WORKS APPLICATION TO THE STATE OF NEW JERSEY DEPARTMENT OF ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION**

**WHEREAS**, the owner of 54 Marshall Hill Road, Block 5708, Lot 4 has made application for a permanent holding tank to serve the facility in lieu of a conventional septic system for an allowable sewage discharge rate of up to 1,995 gallons per day; and

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with N.J.A.C. 7:9A, a permanent holding tank can only be approved by the NJDEP under the TWA program; and

**WHEREAS**, as part of the application process, the NJDEP requires that the Township consent to the application; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township Engineer has reviewed the Treatment Works application submitted to the Department of Environmental Protection on behalf of the aforementioned property; and

**WHEREAS**, the Township Engineer, by way of letter dated August 24, 2010, has advised that the application is in order and his office has no objection to the township consenting to the application; and

**WHEREAS**, approval for a Treatment Works application requires the municipality to, by way of Resolution, consent to the project; and

**WHEREAS**, consent to this application does not preclude the property owner from obtaining any and all necessary local or State approvals for use of the property.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Township of West Milford, County of Passaic, State of New Jersey hereby consents to the Treatment Works Application as submitted for the property known as 54 Marshall Hill Road, Block 5708, Lot 4 with respect to a permanent holding tank to serve the facility in lieu of a conventional septic system.
