2. The aforelisted Officers and Employees shall be compensated in accordance with the preceding Salary Range.

3. **BENEFITS:** Benefits relating to vacation, sick days, personal days, longevity, holidays, bereavement leave and medical insurance shall be those as contained in the contract between the West Milford Municipal Employees Guild and the Township of West Milford and any employment agreement consistent with applicable law.

4. **OVERTIME:** If not otherwise eligible for overtime compensation by contract or law, each full time department and division head, in lieu of overtime compensation as provided in the Guild contract, shall receive three (3) vacation days and up to 35 compensatory hours annually, the latter earned hour for hour for hours worked above forty per week. All other full time employees listed in this ordinance if not otherwise eligible for overtime compensation by contract or law, shall receive 21 compensatory hours annually, plus one half hour for each hour worked above thirty-five or forty hours per week depending on the applicable contract for the

employee's department. Vacation and compensatory time may be used or accumulated as follows: vacation days may be carried for up to one year from January 1 following the year earned, and compensatory hours may be taken no later than April 1 of the year following the year earned.

5. This Ordinance is effective retroactive to January 1, 2004.

6. Any ordinance or parts thereof in conflict or inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to such extent as they are in conflict or inconsist. This ordinance shall take effect 20 days after its final passage by the Township Council.

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP
OF WEST MILFORD AUTHORIZING THE EXECUTION OF A LEASE BETWEEN
THE NEW JERSEY TRANSIT CORPORATION AND THE TOWNSHIP OF WEST
MILFORD
FOR THE LEASE OF TWO BUSES PURSUANT TO FTA SECTION 5310,
THE ELDERLY AND PERSONS WITH DISABILITIES TRANSPORTATION
PROGRAMS**

WHEREAS, the Township of West Milford is qualified by way of SS5310 of the Federal Transit Act to be the recipient of two Blue Bird buses to provide transportation for the elderly and persons with disabilities who reside in the Township; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the terms of the grant agreement, the Township desires to enter into a five (5) year lease for said buses with the New Jersey Transit Corporation; and

WHEREAS, said agreement does not call for any payments to New Jersey Transit Corporation; and

WHEREAS, the Township of West Milford shall be responsible for the maintenance, insurance and the title and registration fees for said vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the Township Council believes that this agreement is in the best interest of the residents of the Township as it promotes transportation assistance for the elderly and persons with disabilities residing within the Township.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Council of the Township of West Milford, that the Mayor is hereby authorized to execute the agreement between New Jersey Transit Corporation and the Township of West Milford for the lease of the following vehicles:

1. 2006 Blue Bird Bus; Model #A3FE3600A, VIN #1BABDCKA56F227740
2. 2006 Blue Bird Bus; Model #A3FE3600A, VIN #1BABDCKA16F227749

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Township will be responsible for the maintenance, insurance and the title and registration fees for said vehicles; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the agreement is subject to final review by the Administration and legal counsel as to appropriate form.
