WHEREAS, the Township's Environmental Commission submitted the following two sites for consideration to the Township Council:

1. Site 1

Eagles Ridge

Block 5301 Lot 20 70.0 acres Ridge Road & Cahill Cross Road

Block 5405, Lot 8 6.9 acres

Total Project Funding Range: \$1,763,30000 to \$2,379,200.00

2. Site 2

Morsetown Road/Sheridan Property

Block 5301, Lot 39 70.0 acres 445 Morsetown Road

Total Project Funding Range: \$562,900.00 to \$761,600.00

WHEREAS, the Environmental Commission also advised the Township Council that the Commission's first priority is Site 1 - Eagles Ridge and the second priority is Site 2 - Morsetown Road/Sheridan Property; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the requirements of the Passaic County Open Space Committee, the Township advertised a Public Notice on May 30, 2005 for the public hearing to be held on June 9, 2005 on the applications for open space funds; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with new requirements of the Passaic County Open Space Committee, the Township did mail by Certified Mail a letter notifying the affected property owners as well as all property owners within 200 feet of the sites being considered for acquisition of the scheduled hearing of June 9, 2005; and

WHEREAS, a public hearing was held on June 9, 2005, at which time public input was solicited on the sites to be considered for acquisition for open space; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Township Council of the Township of West Milford, that it hereby authorizes the Township Administrator to arrange for the submission of all grant application materials as prepared by the West Milford Township Environmental Commission to seek funding from the Passaic County Open Space and Farmland Preservation Trust Fund for the acquisition of these two sites.
