The 2019 General Election will be held on Tuesday, November 5, 2019 with polling hours from 6:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. Registered voters from Passaic County who are unable to get to the polls on Election Day may request their paper Vote by Mail Ballot before Election Day in the Passaic County Clerk’s Offices.

Office hours for In-Person voting are Monday through Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. with extended hours on Saturday, November 2, 2019 from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. and on Monday, November 4, 2019 from 8:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

The County Clerk’s office will also be processing Passport Applications, issue Notary Oaths/Renewals and Veteran’s Photo Identification cards on Saturday November 2, 2019 from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. at 401 Grand Street, Room 130 in Paterson, New Jersey and at the Satellite Office located at 1237 Ringwood Avenue, Haskell (Wanaque), New Jersey.
