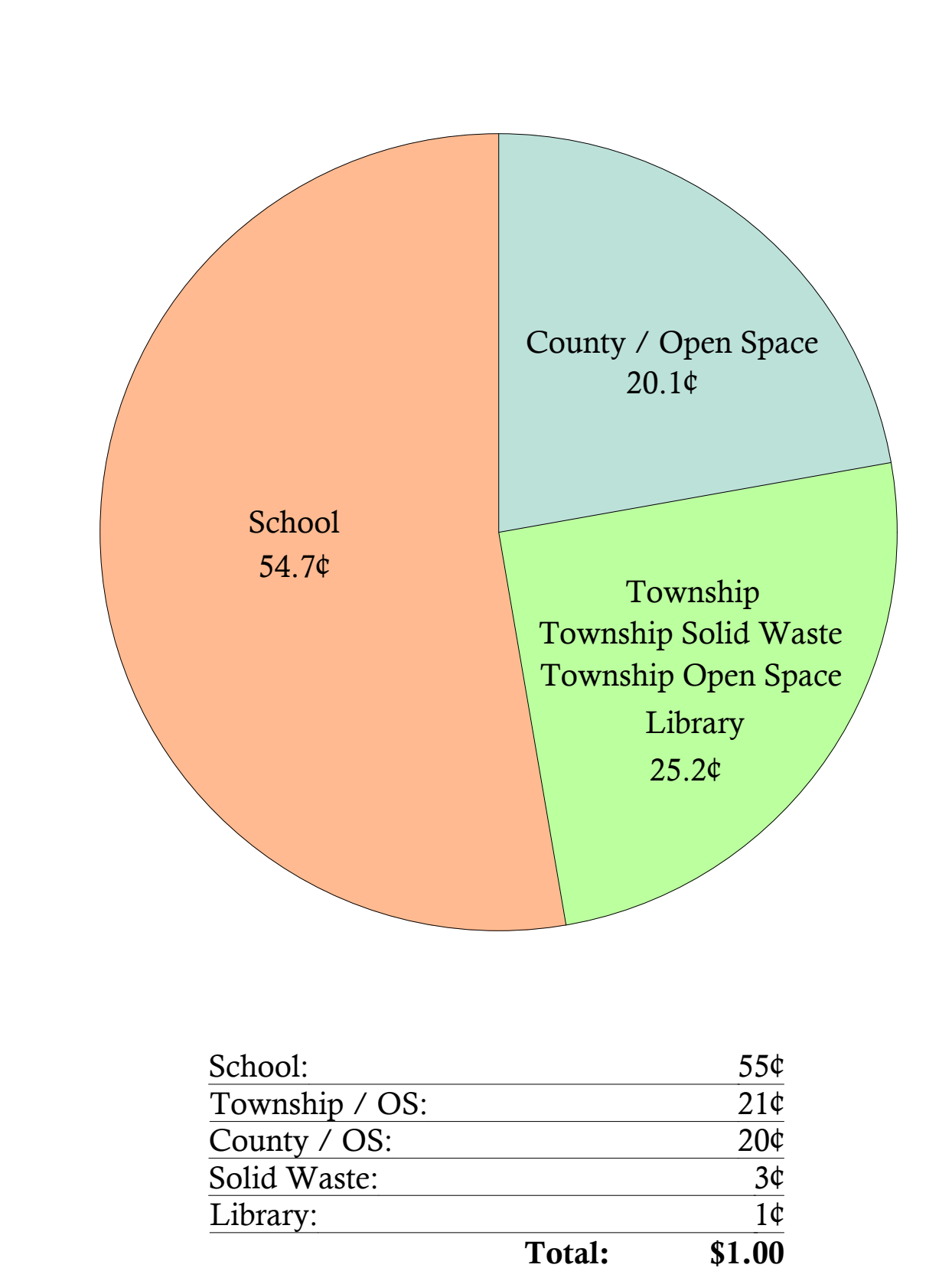

About West Milford

West Milford, an 80-plus square mile municipality located in Passaic County, NJ, sits in the "Heart of the Highlands." Its beautiful mountainous terrain, dotted with nearly forty tranquil lakes, is crisscrossed by narrow roads that run along its scenic valleys and ridges.

Most of its 10,000 homes surround its lakes. Many of these homes, once summer resort bungalows have over the years been enlarged and converted into year-round residences. And over the past twenty years, many newer, larger homes on one- to four-acre lots, as well as two major condominium developments, have been built. With this development history, prospective homeowners can find a range of housing types and costs to suit their particular needs.

A major state highway, Route 23, that winds along its southern boundary, more or less paralleling the Pequannock River, provides its main transportation links to the outside world.

A community widely recognized for its commitment to youth activities, yet recreation programs are available for people of all ages. All family members, not just the younger set, can enjoy a wide variety of recreational, fun, and educational programs, sponsored not only by the Township's Recreation Department, but also its schools, the Police Athletic League, and local churches and civic groups.

Recreational sports, hiking, mountain biking, road cycling, boating, and fishing, attract some hardy tourists, but West Milford's main attraction for local residents is its vast extent of largely undeveloped and state protected forests, nearly 3/4 of the entire municipality.

Despite its enormous size, West Milford is blessed with a small-town atmosphere, the product of not only volunteer and civic group activism and pride, but also a participatory citizenry whose debates fill the local presses and enliven locally televised council meetings.

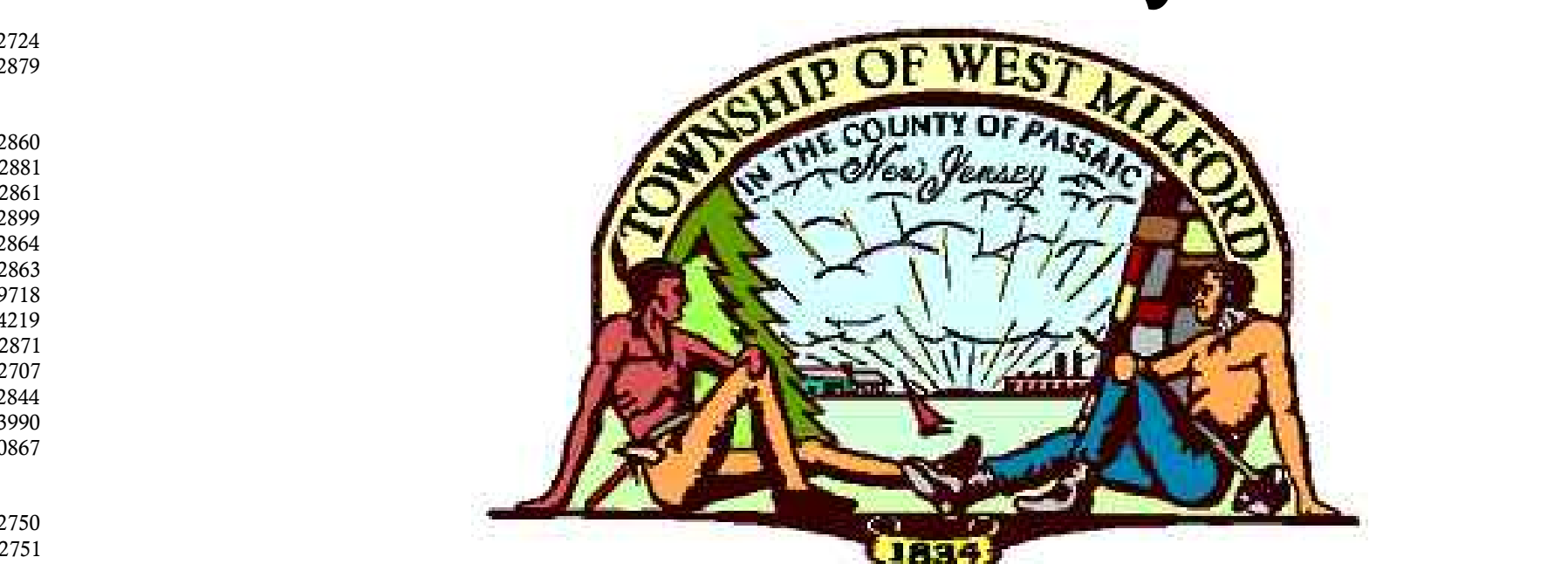

WEST MILFORD TOWNSHIP SNOW SEASON INFORMATION

Garbage and Recycling Collection

- During snow or snow removal operations, garbage and/or recycling pickup may have to be rescheduled. For information contact the Recycling Division office at 973-728-2724.
- The garbage and recycling collection schedule is available on the Township's homepage www.westmilford.org (under Departments / DPW-Recycling & Solid Waste). The schedule is also available through the free Recycle Coach app.
- If snow is forecast and pickup has not yet been cancelled, garbage and/or recycling cans should be placed in the driveway a few feet back from the edge of the road. The Township is not responsible for damaged cans.

No Snow in the Road

- Under Township Code: Chapter 332, Article 5, Section 36, it is prohibited to throw, place or deposit snow or ice into or upon any road within the Township.
- Generally, when snow accumulation exceeds 4", roads are initially opened for access. Depending on duration and total accumulation, roads may be plowed several times throughout the storm. Therefore, driveways may be plowed in repeatedly.
- When clearing driveway snow near the road, it is best to throw it to the right as this may reduce the amount of snow plowed back into driveways.
- Markers along the edge of roads without curb can help to reduce damage to landscaping.

No Parking on Snow Covered Roads

- As per Township Code: Chapter 10, Section 3.4, parking is prohibited on all Township, Public / Private or County roadways for snow plowing and snow removal.

Mailboxes

- Proper location of mailboxes allows for clearing the full width of roads, while reducing the risk of damage to mailboxes. The face of the mailbox should be 6" to 8" back from the curb face or edge of pavement and 41" to 45" above the ground. See Postal Service guidelines at <https://www.usps.com/manage/mailboxes.htm>
- The Township may reimburse up to \$50 for damage when inspected and confirmed that the mailbox has been hit by the plow or the plow truck.
