IMPORTANT INFORMATION & RECYCLING REGULATIONS

COMMINGLE

Plastic Containers: #1, 2, and 5 symbols only

No other plastics can be accepted, including plastic lids and toys. If other plastics are delivered to the disposal market, the Township will be billed double. Comingled materials cannot be placed in plastic bags and will not be collected at the curb. Place recyclable items in a 32-gallon trash can.

Metal Cans: (Tin/Steel) Soup, food, coffee cans, etc.

Aluminum: Food and beverage containers. Soda/beer cans, pet food, pie plates, etc.

Rinsed and clean milk, OJ, broth, juice box containers

Materials not acceptable (put out with refuse):

Mirrors, window or auto glass, bulbs, ceramics, plastics without a number, plastics with numbers 3, 4, 7, 8, and 9, needles/syringes, and oil containers, , plastic bags, plastic film, coat hangers, paint cans, aerosol cans, tar pails, vacuum and pool hoses, pool liners, shower curtains, PVC pipe, plumbing accessories, toys, building products, plastic fencing, wire, electrical equipment, dishware, Styrofoam, food trays, , flower pots, nursery trays, rubber hoses, bowling balls, food or party trays, trash. All latex paint cans must be empty and if not they need to be dried out and put out for garbage. Empty latex paint cans and driveway sealers are not accepted at recycling center.

PAPER & CARDBOARD

Includes the following items that are clean and dry: brown paper bags; magazines; paperboard (cereal boxes, paper towel rolls, etc.); flattened cardboard; newspaper inserts; phone books; junk mail; office paper Does not include the following items: pizza boxes; trash or construction debris; yard waste; packing materials (Styrofoam, bubble wrap etc.); paper cups, plates or towels; wax coated cardboard

Recycling Center will not accept materials that can be placed at the curb for collection

The large containers at the Recycling Center are available for businesses that do not have curbside collections. All Taxpayers may use the containers listed on the front cover for drop off items that are not collected curbside.

Items for Curbside Collection Available to all Taxpayers

PLACE RECYCLING/GARBAGE OUT ON DAY OF COLLECTION PRIOR TO 6:00 AM OR THE NIGHT BEFORE IN SECURE

CONTAINERS- CONTRACTOR STARTS AT 6:00 AM Return containers from curbside before next day.

GARBAGE and TRASH: Collection is once a week with a limit of 3 cans of household garbage, one bulk item and one bundle of construction debris. For garbage, use a secure 32-gallon can no heavier than 50 lbs. Place neatly at curb by 6:00 a.m. or the night before. Remove emptied containers at end of day. Clear area during snow events.

BULKY ITEMS: Items such as furniture and mattresses will be collected on your regularly scheduled garbage collection day

with a limit of one bulk item per collection.

Carpet shall be cut into 4' wide strips, rolled and bundled. Construction debris, 4' long x 3' high tied, no heavier than 50 lbs.

SCRAP METAL & APPLIANCES: 60 pound weight limit per item ,Assorted metals, including refrigerators, stoves, air conditioners, items with 95% or more metal content and pipes and poles no longer than 5 feet, shall be collected once each month, in accordance to schedule below. Freon must be removed from: air conditioners, refrigerators, freezers, and dehumidifiers by a licensed HVAC Tech and a sticker is required. Not included are Electronics (see below), copy machines, propane tanks. Scrap Metal Collected monthly by zones.

To receive service, please call 973-728-2724 no later than 48 hours before collection day to be placed on scrap metal/appliance list.

TIRES: \$3.00 for car tire, \$6.00 for truck tire, fees vary for larger tires sizes. Please call 973-728-2724.

AUTO BATTERIES: All auto batteries can be brought to the Recycling Center. No fee.

MOTOR OIL: Put motor oil in sealed container. .50 cents per gallon. Please call 973-728-2724.

ELECTRONICS: Stereos, computers, TV's, phones, printers, digital cameras, and smoke detectors.

No Curbside Pick-up of electronic devices!

LEAVES: Bring to Compost Site located on Lycosky Drive. **No Curbside Pick-up!**

GRASS CLIPPINGS: Grass should either be cut or left as natural fertilizer on your lawn or home compost.

Residents may also bring clippings to the Compost Site on Lycosky Drive. No Curbside Pick-up!

BRUSH/CHRISTMAS TREES: Brush and Christmas Trees are accepted free of charge for WM residents (less than 4" in diameter) at Skytop Recycling. No Stumps or Construction Debris. Skytop Recycling is located at 80 Airport Road, West Milford, Mon - Fri 7am to 3.15 pm, Sat. 7am to 11.45 am, Closed on Sunday, PHONE: 973-728-4444.

HOUSEHOLD HAZAROUS WASTE: Passaic County sponsors Household Hazardous Waste Collection. Call the County hotline at 973-305-5738 for additional information.
