## RESOLUTION OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WEST MILFORD, COUNTY OF PASSAIC AND STATE OF NEW JERSEY AUTHORIZING A GRANT APPLICATION SUBMISSION TO THE PRESERVE NEW JERSEY HISTORIC PRESERVATION FUND, 2025 GRANT APPLICATION HISTORIC SITE MANAGEMENT BY THE FRIENDS OF WALLISCH HOMESTEAD FOR THE WALLISCH HOME RESTORATION

**WHEREAS**, the Preserve New Jersey Historic Preservation Fund awards grants to properties listed in the New Jersey Register of Historic Places; and

**WHEREAS,** the Friends of Wallisch Homestead (FOWH) desires to further the public interest by obtaining funding in the amount of \$75,000 from the Preserve New Jersey Historic Preservation Fund. This Grant will provide for the preparation of Architectural Plans, Designs, Specifications, Cost Estimates and other Construction Documents to begin the Restoration of the Wallisch Home.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Township Council of the Township of West Milford, County of Passaic and State of New Jersey as follows:

- 1. The FOWH be and hereby are authorized to make application, provided all required information and documents as required and correspond as necessary, for a grant to the Preserve New Jersey Historic Preservation Fund.
- 2. The FOWH is hereby authorized to execute a grant agreement and any amendment thereof with the Preserve New Jersey Historic Preservation Fund for the Wallisch Home Restoration.
- 3. The funds provided by the Preserve New Jersey Historic Preservation Fund may provide up to 75% of total project costs not to exceed \$75,000. The FOWH must demonstrate the ability to match 25% of the total project cost for which the grant is requested.
- 4. The application agrees to comply with all applicable Federal, State, County and local laws, rules and regulations in its performance of the project.

This Resolution shall take effect immediately.
