


Community Services & Recreation presents:

The Game of Pickleball





Pickleball is the fastest growing sport in the country. It's a lively racquet game for all ages and abilities. Many kids and teenagers play it in physical education classes in middle and high schools. Adults and Senior Adults enjoy the social aspects and the ability to stay active in towns and retirement communities.

Pickleball is a racquet sport which combines elements of badminton, tennis, and table tennis. The rules are simple and the game is easy for beginners to learn; it can develop into a quick, fast-paced, competitive game for experienced players. It is played with a paddle and a plastic ball and can be played indoors or out. The court is about 1/3 the size of a tennis court so there is a much smaller area for each player to cover.
