ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WEST MILFORD, COUNTY OF PASSAIC, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING PART 1 ADMINISTRATIVE LEGISLATION CHAPTER 10-3 PARKING TO CREATE A NEW SECTION 10-3.10 PROHIBITING CERTAIN OVERNIGHT COMMERCIAL VEHICLE PARKING WITHIN THE TOWNSHIP CODE

WHEREAS, in order to maintain the public's health, safety and welfare, the Mayor and Township Council of the Township of West Milford recognize the need to update Chapter 10-3, to prohibit certain commercial vehicles from parking overnight on all roadways; and

WHEREAS, upon the recommendation of the Township of West Milford Police Department, this update is necessary to maintain public safety.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Mayor and Township Council of the Township of West Milford, County of Passaic, and the State of New Jersey that the Township of West Milford Code shall be amended and updated, only as follows to add the following section to be entitled 10-3.10 Overnight Parking of Certain Commercial Vehicles Prohibited.

SECTION 1. 10:3.10 Overnight Parking of Certain Commercial Vehicles Prohibited

A. Definitions. As used in this subsection:

LARGE COMMERCIAL VEHICLES shall mean those vehicles weighing more than 3.5 tons with a height of more than 9.5 feet, including installed accessories and/or cargo area/work platform more than 14 feet in length.

MEDIUM COMMERCIAL VEHICLES shall mean those vehicles weighing less than 3.5 tons and less than 9.5 feet in height, including installed accessories and/or cargo area/work platform less than 14 feet in length.

LIGHT COMMERCIAL VEHICLES shall mean those weighing less than 2.5 tons and a cargo area/work platform that is less than the height of the vehicle cab and less than 9 feet in length.

PARK OR PARKING shall mean the standing or waiting on a street, road or highway of a vehicle not actually engaged in receiving or discharging passengers or merchandise, unless in obedience to traffic regulations or traffic signs or signals.

PERSON shall mean natural persons, firms, associations, partnerships and corporations.

PICKUP TRUCK shall mean a truck or other motor vehicle with an open back designed, used or maintained primarily for the regular transportation of property or delivery of services.

STORE shall mean keeping for safe care or custody whether temporarily or permanently.

TRUCK shall mean every motor vehicle designed, used or maintained primarily for the regular transportation of property or delivery of services.

Van shall mean an enclosed motor vehicle designed, used or maintained primarily for the regular transportation of property or delivery of services.

- B. Parking Restrictions. No person shall park or store any Large Commercial vehicle on any residential street, highway, right-of-way, public place or private road within the Township between the hours of 9:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m.
- C. Exceptions. Nothing herein shall be deemed to prohibit the parking or storing of any commercial vehicles, or equipment related thereto, on a residential street while it is being used in the transaction of business with the owner or occupant of residential property in the area or is in the area for the purpose of installing, maintaining or performing public utility services.
- D. Overnight parking of medium and light commercial vehicles owned by residents is limited to no more than one and two per household, respectively. Alternatively, one household may park on-street overnight a maximum of one medium and one light commercial vehicle.
- E. The posting of "No parking overnight for trailers, buses, trucks and commercial vehicles" signs shall be deemed to be notice to the owner and/or operator thereof.
- F. Enforcement. Enforcement of these regulations shall be the responsibility of the Police Department. It shall also be the responsibility of all the Township departments to report any suspected violations of these regulations to the Police Department.
- G. Penalties. Any person convicted of violating this subsection shall be liable to maximum penalty as set forth in Article III, General Penalty for each violation, and each day in which such violation continues shall constitute a separate violation or offense.
- **SECTION 2**. All ordinances or parts of ordinances of the Township of West Milford inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
- **SECTION 3**. If any section, subsection, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid by any court or competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining portion of this Ordinance.
- **SECTION 4**. This Ordinance may be renumbered for purposes of codification.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance shall take effect upon final passage, approval, and publication as required by law.

BOND ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE IMPROVEMENT OF WESTBROOK ROAD IN AND BY THE TOWNSHIP OF WEST MILFORD, IN THE COUNTY OF PASSAIC, NEW JERSEY, APPROPRIATING \$835,000 THEREFOR AND AUTHORIZING THE ISSUANCE OF \$342,000 BONDS OR NOTES OF THE TOWNSHIP FOR FINANCING SUCH APPROPRIATION

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE TOWNSHIP COUNCIL OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WEST MILFORD, IN THE COUNTY OF PASSAIC, NEW JERSEY (not less than two-thirds of all the members thereof affirmatively concurring), AS FOLLOWS:

- **Section 1**. The improvement described in Section 3 of this bond ordinance is hereby authorized as a general improvement to be made or acquired by The Township of West Milford, in the County of Passaic, New Jersey. For the said improvement or purpose stated in said Section 3, there is hereby appropriated the sum of \$835,000, said sum being inclusive of all appropriations heretofore made therefor and including the sum of \$18,000 as the down payment for said improvement or purpose required by law and now available therefor by virtue of provision in a previously adopted budget or budgets of the Township for down payment or for capital improvement purposes and including also the sum of \$475,000 received or expected to be received by the Township from the New Jersey Department of Transportation as a grant-in-aid of financing said improvement or purpose.
- Section 2. For the financing of said improvement or purpose, including for the purpose of applicable United States Treasury regulations the reimbursement of expenditures heretofore or hereafter made therefor, and to meet the part of said \$835,000 appropriation not provided for by application hereunder of said down payment and grant, negotiable bonds of the Township are hereby authorized to be issued in the principal amount of \$342,000 pursuant to the Local Bond Law of New Jersey. In anticipation of the issuance of said bonds and to temporarily finance said improvement or purpose, negotiable notes of the Township in a principal amount not exceeding \$342,000 are hereby authorized to be issued pursuant to and within the limitations prescribed by said Local Bond Law.
- **Section 3.** a) The improvement hereby authorized and purpose for the financing of which said obligations are to be issued is the improvement of Westbrook Road in and by the Township, including the construction or reconstruction therein of a roadway pavement at least equal in useful life or durability to a roadway pavement of Class B construction (as such term is used or referred to in section 40A:2-22 of said Local Bond Law), together with all pedestrian and bikeway improvements, drainage facilities, widening, landscaping, milling, signage, structures, equipment, site work, work and materials necessary therefor or incidental thereto, all as shown on and in accordance with the plans and specifications therefor on file or to be filed in the office of the Township Clerk and hereby approved.
- b) The estimated maximum amount of bonds or notes to be issued for said purpose is \$342,000.
- c) The estimated cost of said purpose is \$835,000, the excess thereof over the said estimated maximum amount of bonds or notes to be issued therefor being the amount of the said \$18,000 down payment for said purpose and the amount of the said \$475,000 grant from the New Jersey Department of Transportation.
- **Section 4.** The following additional matters are hereby determined, declared, recited and stated:

 a) The said purpose described in Section 3 of this bond ordinance is not a current expense and is a property or improvement which the Township may lawfully acquire or make as a general improvement, and no part of the cost thereof has been or shall be specially assessed on property specially benefitted thereby.

- b) The period of usefulness of said purpose within the limitations of said Local Bond Law, according to the reasonable life thereof computed from the date of the said bonds authorized by this bond ordinance, is ten (10) years.
- c) The supplemental debt statement required by said Local Bond Law has been duly made and filed in the office of the Township Clerk and a complete executed duplicate thereof has been filed in the office of the Director of the Division of Local Government Services in the Department of Community Affairs of the State of New Jersey, and such statement shows that the gross debt of the Township as defined in said Local Bond Law is increased by the authorization of the bonds and notes provided for in this bond ordinance by \$342,000, and the said obligations authorized by this bond ordinance will be within all debt limitations prescribed by said Local Bond Law.
- d) An aggregate amount not exceeding \$90,000 for interest on said obligations, costs of issuing said obligations and other items of expense listed in and permitted under section 40A:2-20 of said Local Bond Law may be included as part of the cost of said improvement and is included in the foregoing estimate thereof.
- **Section 5**. The funds from time to time received by the Township on account of the grant referred to in Section 1 of this bond ordinance shall be used for financing the improvement or purpose described in Section 3 of this bond ordinance by application thereof either to direct payment of the costs of said improvement or purpose, or to payment or reduction of the authorization of the obligations of the Township authorized by this bond ordinance. Any such funds so received may and all such funds so received which are not required for direct payment of such costs shall, be held and applied by the Township as funds applicable only to the payment of obligations of the Township authorized by this bond ordinance.
- Section 6. All bond anticipation notes issued hereunder shall mature at such times as may be determined by the chief financial officer, the treasurer or the acting chief financial officer of the Township (the "Chief Financial Officer"), provided that no note shall mature later than one year from its date. The notes shall bear interest at such rate or rates and be in such form as may be determined by the Chief Financial Officer. The Chief Financial Officer shall determine all matters in connection with the notes issued pursuant to this bond ordinance, and the Chief Financial Officer's signature upon the notes shall be conclusive evidence as to all such determinations. All notes issued hereunder may be renewed from time to time subject to the provisions of N.J.S.A. §40A:2-8. The Chief Financial Officer is hereby authorized to sell part or all of the notes from time to time at public or private sale at not less than par and to deliver them to the purchasers thereof upon receipt of payment of the purchase price plus accrued interest from their dates to the dates of delivery thereof. The Chief Financial Officer is directed to report in writing to the governing body of the Township at the meeting next succeeding the date when any sale or delivery of the notes pursuant to this bond ordinance is made. Such report must include the principal amount, interest rate and maturities of the notes sold, the price obtained and the name of the purchaser.
- **Section 7**. The full faith and credit of the Township are hereby pledged to the punctual payment of the principal of and interest on the said obligations authorized by this bond ordinance. Said obligations shall be direct, unlimited obligations of the Township, and the Township shall be obligated to levy ad valorem taxes upon all the taxable property within the Township for the payment of said obligations and interest thereon without limitation of rate or amount.
- **Section 8.** The capital budget or temporary capital budget of the Township is hereby amended to conform with the provisions of this ordinance to the extent of any inconsistency herewith and the resolutions promulgated by the Local Finance Board showing all detail of the amended capital budget or temporary capital budget and capital program as approved by the Director, Division of Local Government Services, are on file with the Township Clerk and are available for public inspection.
