NJDEP Freshwater Wetlands GP #17 = 1615-09-0033.1 LUP 210001 and Flood Hazard Area Indiv Permit = 1615-09-0033.1 LUP 210003 regarding B 9302; L 16, Nosenzo Pond Road, for the construction of a walkway and boardwalk around an existing structure within the riparian zone of Nosenzo Pond and the transition area of the on-site adjacent freshwater wetlands on the site.

7. NJDEP application notification, dated April 27, 2022, regarding Freshwater Wetlands and Flood Hazard Area Indiv Permit, regarding the NJDOT Rt 23 Bridge over Pequannock River/Hamburg Tpk. The new replacement bridge will be 417 ft long between abutments, and 84 ft wide with approximately 22 ft of the widening occurring on the west side of the existing bridge. During construction of the four-lane bridge, traffic is proposed to travel on a diversionary road with a temporary bridge constructed to the west side of the existing bridge.
