Highlands Water Protection and Planning Act Correspondence

1. Notification dated July 27, 2022 from Veoilia North America advising that an application for a Highlands Applicability Determination – Exemption #11 was being submitted to NJDEP – Land Use Regulation, regarding proposed wastewater treatment plant projects, including the installation of frac tanks which act as equalization tanks, preventing wet weather overflows. The projects will take place at the Awosting WWTP – Block 3802; Lot 3, Birch Hill WWTP – Block 6203; Lot 17, and Bald Eagle Village WWTP – Block 7801; Lots 65, 66, & 67.

NJ Department of Environmental Protection Correspondence

1. Notification dated August 30, 2022 from YMCA of Montclair advising of an application to the NJDEP requesting a Freshwater Wetlands Letter of Interpretation – Line Verification for 29 acre site located at Block 14108; Lot 6, 131 Germantown Road.

Notification from Houser Engineering, dated August 29, 2022, advising that an application was being submitted to the NJDEP for a Treatment Works Approval for Greenwood Lake Services LLC, 322, 330 & 341 Lakeside Road, Block 3107; Lots 1 & 2, and Block 3101; Lot 9, for the construction of an On-Site Wastewater Treatment and Disposal System alteration.

3. Suspected Hazardous Substance Notice dated August 16, 2022 regarding Block 13101; Lot 2, 13 Mallory Rd., with respect to a rusted 330 Gal oil tank that leaked into the soil; cleanup was in progress.

4. Suspected Hazardous Substance Notice dated August 31, 2022 regarding Block 12902; Lot 7, 244 High Crest Drive, with respect to a leaking 550 Gal UST; cleanup pending.

5. Notification from LAN Associates, dated August 17, 2022, regarding an application to be submitted to the NJDEP for a Flood Hazard Area Individual Permit for the proposed construction of a new single family dwelling at 4 Clubhouse Trail, Block 504; Lot 1.

6. Notification dated September 1, 2022 received from the NJDOT regarding an application for a Flood Hazard Area Individual Permit to be submitted to the NJDEP for the Rt 23 Bridge Over Pequannock River/Hamburg Turnpike. The proposed project will replace the existing bridge that was constructed in 1934. The new replacement bridge will be 417 ft long between abutments and 84 ft wide with approximately 22 ft of the widening occurring on the west side of the existing bridge. During construction, traffic is proposed to travel on a diversionary road with a temporary bridge constructed to the west side of the existing bridge, while a portion of the final bridge, wide enough to carry four lanes of traffic, is constructed. Hardship Exceptions are being sought for work within channel, work within 150 ft of the top of the bank along a regulated water with 300 ft riparian zone, riparian impacts that exceed the allowable, fill in the floodway, and changes in flood elevations.
