ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WEST MILFORD, COUNTY OF PASSAIC, STATE OF NEW JERSEY CONCERNING SALARIES AND COMPENSATION FOR SPECIAL POLICE OFFICERS

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of West Milford, County of Passaic, State of New Jersey that pursuant to Chapter 33 entitled Personnel of the Revised General Ordinances of the Township of West Milford, New Jersey, 2007 the following Officers and Employees here below stated shall be classified by job title with the corresponding pay ranges:

1. TEMPORARY, PART TIME AND SEASONAL EMPLOYEES

- 2. CLOTHING ALLOWANCE Special Officers qualify for a clothing and maintenance allowance annually. Half the annual amount payable on or about December 1st of each year for those officers working a minimal of 35 hours since January 1st of that year, with an additional payment of \$2.50 each hour worked in addition to the minimum 35, with the total allowance not exceeding the maximum amount for that year regardless of the number of all hours worked. Special Officers qualifying for a clothing and maintenance allowance upon the submission for receipts for actual purchases of up to \$410.00.
- 3. HOLIDAY PAY Officers shall be entitled to time and one-half pay for all hours worked on New Year's Day, Easter, Memorial Day, July 4th, Labor Day and December 25.
- 4. CALL-OUTS All callouts are payable for time worked, with a minimum of two hours pay including mandatory training.
- 5. Township Road Work Callouts payable by normal hourly wage.
- 6. Contractor Road Work Callouts payable at \$30.00 per hour.
- 7. GENERAL PROVISIONS Any ordinance or parts thereof in conflict or inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to such extent as they are in conflict or inconsistent.

ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WEST MILFORD, COUNTY OF PASSAIC, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING AND SUPPLEMENTING CHAPTER 271, "POLICE SERVICES CHARGES," OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES

BE IT ORDAINED by the Township Council of the Township of West Milford, County of Passaic, State of New Jersey, as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 271 Police Services Charges, Section §271-2, Rate for employment by third parties, of the Revised General Ordinances of the Township of West Milford, is hereby amended and supplemented to read as follows:

§ 271-2. Rate for employment by third parties.

Third parties seeking to utilize Township police services must coordinate the services through the Police Department. The Township shall be paid for the outside employment of police by third parties at a rate equal to the overtime rate of the officer being employed or the average overtime rate as of January 1st of that year, whichever is greater. Special Police Officers shall be paid at their straight time rate. An additional 10% shall be added for benefits, supervision, and other overhead. The Township may require the establishment of an escrow account initially funded at an amount estimated to cover the cost of the employment, which shall be posted at least 10 days prior to the date in which the employment is needed.

- **SECTION 2.** All ordinances of the Township of West Milford which are inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
- **SECTION 3.** If any section, subsection, clause or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid by any court or competent jurisdiction, such decision shall not affect the remaining portion of this ordinance.
- **SECTION 4.** This Ordinance may be renumbered for purposes of codification.
- **SECTION 5.** EFFECTIVE DATE This ordinance shall take effect on April 1, 2024.

ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WEST MILFORD COUNTY OF PASSAIC STATE OF NEW JERSEY ADDING A NEW CHAPTER ENTITLED "BUSINESS INSURANCE REGISTRATION" OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES

WHEREAS, the State and General Assembly of the State of New Jersey enacted Bill No. 1368 which institutes minimum liability insurance requirement for owners of businesses and rental units.; and

WHEREAS, the law gives municipalities flexibility with respect to handling the annual registration of certificates of insurance; and

WHEREAS, the Township Council has determined that it is necessary to establish within the Code, regulations regarding the business and rental unit liability insurance implementation and an administrative fee for the annual registration; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Council of the Township of West Milford, in the County of Passaic, and State of New Jersey wishes to amend the Code of the Township of West Milford to add a new Chapter entitle Business Insurance Registration to read as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter **XX** Business Insurance Registration

§ XX-1 INSURANCE COVERAGE REQUIRED.

- a. The owner of a business or the owner of a rental unit or units, other than a multifamily home as set forth in this section below, shall be required to maintain liability insurance for all negligent acts and omissions in an amount of no less than \$500,000 for combined property damage and bodily injury to or death of one or more persons in any one accident or occurrence.
- b. The owner of a multifamily home which is four or fewer units, one of which is owner-occupied, shall maintain liability insurance for negligent acts and omissions in an amount of no less than \$300,000 for combined property damage and bodily injury to or death of one or more persons in any one accident or occurrence.

§ XX-2 ANNUAL REGISTRATION REQUIREMENT.

- a. Any owner of a business or rental unit(s) required to maintain insurance as set forth in § XX-1, above, is required to register the certificate of such insurance coverage with the Township Clerk as follows:
 - 1. Within 30 days of the date this chapter takes effect.
 - 2. Within 30 days of the date of establishment of said business or rental unit(s) within the Township.
 - 3. On or before January 15 or each year following enactment of this section.
- b. A new certificate will be required annually for each calendar year. All certificates shall be renewed no later than January 15 of each year. It shall be the responsibility of any owner conducting, operating or engaging in any business covered by this requirement to apply for a certificate at the Office of the Clerk.

§ XX-3 DEFINITIONS.

The following words and phrases, when used in this chapter, shall have the meanings ascribed to them in this section, except where the context clearly indicates a different meaning:

BUSINESS

Any person offering and/or engaged in buying, selling, storing and/or transferring merchandise, goods, real property, personal property, moneys, services and/or other items who do so for a fee, price, retainer,

commission, percentage and/or other means of compensation for the purpose, stated or otherwise, of realizing a profit or other gain.

CERTIFICATE OF INSURANCE

The certificate of insurance form.

MUNICIPAL INSURANCE REGISTRATION CERTIFICATE

The certificate issued by the Municipal Clerk indicating compliance with the registration requirement.

MUNICIPAL INSURANCE REGISTRATION FORM

The registration form to be filed with the Municipal Clerk.

MUNICIPALITY

The Township of West Milford.

§ XX-4 MUNICIPAL INSURANCE REGISTRATION FORM; REQUIRED INFORMATION; ISSUANCE OF CERTIFICATE.

- a. Any business owner, rental until owner, or owner of a multifamily home that is four or fewer units, one of which is owner occupied, located within the Township of West Milford shall file a completed municipal insurance registration form and certificate of insurance with the Clerk and shall pay the required fee.
- b. The municipal insurance registration form shall contain the following information for each owner applying for a certificate:
 - 1. The name of the owner.
 - 2. The nature of and address of the business, rental unit(s) or multifamily home(s).
 - 3. The business address of the owner.
 - 4. The home address of the owner.
 - 5. The business telephone number of the owner.
 - 6. The home telephone number and/or cell number of the owner.
 - 7. The trade name or other business identification titles used by the owner.
- c. The Clerk shall issue a municipal insurance registration certificate to any owner who files a completed municipal insurance registration form with certificate of insurance demonstrating the required coverage, and pays the required fee.
- d. Upon receipt of the requirements of § XX-4c, the municipal insurance registration certificate shall be issued along with a copy of the completed municipal insurance registration form with an acknowledgment by the Clerk that it has been properly filed.

§ XX-5 LICENSING TWO OR MORE BUSINESSES OR LOCATIONS.

- a. In the event that two or more businesses occupy the same location, the owner shall be required to complete a separate municipal insurance registration form and obtain a separate certificate for each such business.
- b. In the event that the same owner conducts businesses at two or more locations, a separate business registration form and certificate shall be required for each location.

§ XX-6 CHANGES IN BUSINESSES OR LOCATIONS OR OWNERS.

Every owner having a municipal insurance registration certificate for a business or rental unit or multifamily home of four or few units, one of which is owner-occupied, that ceases to operate, changes the principal activity in which it is engaged, changes its location and/or locations in the municipality, moves out of the municipality or changes owners and/or managers, must submit written notice to the Clerk within 30 days of such change. In the event of cessation of business or moving out of the municipality, the person having a certificate for a business must provide the name, address and home telephone number of the person or principal officer of the business to the Clerk within 30 days of such event.

§ XX-7 COMPLIANCE WITH APPLICABLE LAWS AND ORDINANCES.

Issuance of a municipal insurance registration certificate by the municipality does not evidence

compliance with other applicable rules, regulations, ordinances and statutes of the municipality, county and State of New Jersey, or other regulatory agencies having jurisdiction over the activities of the certificate holder.

§ XX-8 REGISTRATION FEE.

The annual fee for registration of the certificate of insurance pursuant to this section shall be \$20, due at the time the certificate of insurance is to be registered with the Township Clerk.

§ XX-9 VIOLATIONS AND PENALTIES.

If the owner of a business or rental unit(s) subject to the registration requirements of this section is found to be in violation of these provisions, a fine of not less than \$500 but no more than \$5,000 may be assessed against same through a summary proceeding in accordance with the provisions of in N.J.S.A. 2A:58-10 et seq.

SECTION 2. All ordinances of the Township of West Milford, which are inconsistent with the provisions of this Ordinance, are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

SECTION 3. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this Ordinance.

SECTION 4. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage, approval, and publication as required by law.

SECTION 5. This Ordinance may be renumbered for codification purposes.

ORDINANCE READOPTING ORDINANCE 2003-02 TO VACATE CERTAIN PUBLIC RIGHTS IN A ROAD KNOWN AS "TENAFLY COURT" OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WEST MILFORD, COUNTY OF PASSAIC, STATE OF NEW JERSEY

WHEREAS, Ordinance 2003-02 has been previously adopted and enacted into law and duly published as the law provides; and

WHEREAS, this Ordinance will readopt Ordinance 2003-02 that previously was omitted in the recording with the Passaic County Clerk; and

WHEREAS, a recent pending real property sale recognized that Tenafly Court was omitted from the Passaic County Clerk records and is needed for the real property sale to proceed; and

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township of West Milford Township Council finds that the readopting of Ordinance 2003-02 is as follows:

WHEREAS, Tenafly Court was dedicated to the public by virtue of inclusion on a filed map entitled "Fifth Map of Upper Greenwood Lake" which was filed with the Passaic County Register on August 1932, as Map No. 943; and

WHEREAS, in response to a road assessment petition by residents, the Township Council adopted Ordinance No. 1985-7 on June 19, 1985, accepting the roads surrounding, but not including, Tenafly Court, on the basis of recommendations from the Township Engineer not to accept Tenafly Court because it served no public need; and

WHEREAS, it continues to be the recommendation of the current Township Engineer that Tenafly Court be vacated due to the fact that it serves no foreseeable future public need as a right-away; and

WHEREAS, the Township of West Milford has determined that it wishes to vacate the public interest in Tenafly Court.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Council of the Township of West Milford, in the County of Passaic and State of New Jersey, as follows:

- 1. Tenafly Court which was created by the "Fifth Map of Upper Greenwood Lake" which was filed with the Passaic County Register on August 8, 1932, as Map No. 943, shall be vacated.
- 2. That the vacation of the above-described property shall in no way affect any private rights which may exist at the time of passage of this Ordinance.
- 3. That pursuant to law al rights and privileges possessed by any public utility are hereby reserved and exempted from the effects of this Ordinance.
- 4. That a copy of this Ordinance together with a certified copy of the proof of publication shall be filed with the Township Clerk and the proper County office according to law.
- 5. After introduction, this Ordinance shall be referred to the Township Planning Board for review and comment pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:55D-26, -32 and -33 since it is a vacation.
- 6. If any section or provision of this Ordinance shall be held invalid in any Court of competent jurisdiction, the same shall not affect the other sections or provisions of this Ordinance, except so far as the section or provision so declared invalid shall be inseparable from the remainder or any portion thereof.

- 7. The introduction of this Ordinance shall be advertised pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:49-2, provided, however that notice as to introduction and public hearing shall be made, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40:49-6 at least (10) days prior to the public hearing and adoption hereof.
- 8. Notice of the introduction of this Ordinance and the time and place when and where this Ordinance will be further considered for public hearing and final passage, including a copy of this ordinance, shall be mailed to every person whose lands may be affected by this Ordinance, so far as same may be ascertained, directed to the last known post-office address, in accordance with the provision of N.J.S.A. 40:49-6.
- 9. Within sixty (60) days after adoption of this Ordinance, the Township Clerk shall cause this Ordinance, certified under the seal of the Township, to be filed in the office wherein conveyances of lands are recorded in the County of Passaic.
- 10. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances which are inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.
- 11. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately after final passage and publication in the accordance with the laws of the State of New Jersey.
- 12. If any section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this Ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this ordinance.
- 13. This Ordinance may be renumbered for purposes of codification.

SECTION 1 Chapter 135 "Fees & Costs", § 135-2 Department of Community Services and Recreation" are amended as follows:

- E. A nonrefundable maintenance fee of \$25 shall be charged for each group use permit that requires the opening, closing and/or cleaning of a facility.
- F. Permit fees: Bubbling Springs Members will be charged a nonrefundable administrative/user fee of \$30 for guest groups numbering 25 or more people. Permits must be filled out at the Parks and Recreation office. Groups of under 25 do not need to have a permit or pay a maintenance fee. They must make arrangements with the Lake Director prior to the party.
- G. Use of Teen Center/Coffee House.
 - (1) Event permits may be issued for use of the West Milford Teen Center/Coffee House by the Community Services and Recreation Department. The fee for such use shall be a one- time fee of \$150 for a four hour rental. Time exceeding the initial four hours shall be charged at the rate of \$25 per hour. Each event shall require a security deposit of \$200.
 - Use of the Teen Center shall be subject to all requirements associated with the issuance of event permits under Township policy, and the Township's caretaker must be present during any event.
- H. Use of West Milford Recreation Center
 - (1) \$25 per hour, per gym rental fees to local nonprofit organizations upon the issuance of permits and proof of proper insurance has been provided. Local nonprofit organizations are defined as registered organizations under § 501(c)(3) of the Federal Tax Code, with an established business address in West Milford Township.
 - (2) \$100 per hour, per gym rental fees to nonlocal not-for-profit organizations based outside the Township of West Milford. Nonprofit organizations are defined as registered organizations under § 501(c)(3) of the Federal Tax Code.
 - (3) \$100 per hour, per gym rental fees to local for-profit organizations upon the issuance of permits and proof of proper insurance has been provided.
 - (4) Concession Stand rental fee: \$75 for three hours and \$25 for each additional hour.
 - (5) Exemptions:
 - (a) Fees will not be assessed to local nonprofit organizations defined in Subsection I (1) if requested use occurs during regular operating hours of the West Milford Recreation Center, as established by the Township of West Milford Department of Community Services.
- I. The Department of Community Services and Recreation is to provide all currently appointed members of boards, committees and commissions established by ordinance a \$5 discount for their own registration for each of the programs and events offered by the Department. All such members shall also be entitled to receive the same rates for Bubbling Springs as is provided to seniors.
- J. Event permits may be issued for use of the Recreation rooms of the Township Library by the Community Services and Recreation Department. The fee for such use shall be \$0.

ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF WEST MILFORD, COUNTY OF PASSAIC, STATE OF NEW JERSEY AMENDING CHAPTER 420 LAND USE PROCEDURES AND CHAPTER 500 ZONING TO PERMIT MICROBREWERIES AND SIMILAR ESTABLISHMENTS IN CERTAIN ZONES OF THE REVISED GENERAL ORDINANCES OF THE TOWNSHIP

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Township Council has received a request to review whether microbreweries, craft distilleries, brewpubs, and wineries in residential districts with large minimum lot sizes are an appropriate land use within the Township; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Township Council wish to encourage agritourism, farming, and related uses within the Township; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Township Council have determined that permitting microbreweries and similar establishments as defined herein in appropriate locations would be beneficial to the general welfare of the community; and

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED, by the Township Council of the Township of West Milford, in the County of Passaic, and State of New Jersey as follows:

SECTION 1. Chapter 420 "Land Use Procedures" is amended to read as follows:

"§ 420-6 Definitions.

BREWPUB

Microbreweries which are associated with a restaurant.

CRAFT DISTILLERY

A craft distillery is a distillery holding a craft distillery license issued by the State of New Jersey as defined by N.J.S.A. 33:1-10 3d producing up to 20,000 gallons of distilled alcoholic beverages per year. The holder of this license shall be entitled to sell this product at retail to consumers on the licensed premises of the brewery for consumption on the premises, but only in connection with a tour of the distillery, or for consumption off the premises in a quantity of not more than five liters per person, and to offer any person not more than three samples per calendar day for sampling purposes only. Sampling means the gratuitous offering of an open container not exceeding 1/2 ounce serving pursuant to licensure issued by the Director of the State Division of Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC).

MICROBREWERY

A microbrewery is a brewery holding a limited brewery license issued by the State of New Jersey as defined by N.J.S.A. 33:1-10.1b, producing less than 15,000 barrels of 31 gallons of malt beverage per year. The holder of this license shall be entitled to sell this product at retail to consumers on the licensed premises of the brewery for consumption on the premises, but only in connection with a tour of the brewery, or for consumption off the premises in a quantity of not more than 15.5 fluid gallons per person, and to offer samples for sampling purposes only pursuant to licensure issued by the Director of the State Division of Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC).

WINERY

A winery is a business operating for consumption of wine on or off the winery's premises, and for sampling purposes for consumption on the premises, in order to showcase New Jersey viniculture when operated by

one who holds a license permitting same issued by the Director of the State Division of Alcoholic Beverage Control (ABC) and who operates as permitted by the ABC regulations."

SECTION 2. Chapter 500 "Zoning" is amended to include the following new section as follows:

"Article III Residential District

§ 500-8 Principal permitted uses on the land and in buildings.

M. Microbreweries, craft distilleries, brewpubs, and wineries in the R-3 and R-4 Districts on lots greater than or equal to five (5) acres and in accordance with applicable State regulations."

All bonds, notes, deeds, contracts and written obligations of the Township shall be executed on its behalf by the Mayor or, in the event of any inability to act, the Council President.
- B. The Township Council shall determine not later than the annual reorganization meeting whether a full-time Mayor will be approved for that calendar year. Should a full-time Mayor be appointed by a majority of Township Council members, the full-time Mayoral duties and responsibilities shall include, but not be limited to:
 - 1) Serving as Township liaison to the State and County on public works and health matters;
 - 2) Managing grants;
 - 3) Overseeing major projects and Township initiatives;
 - 4) Coordinating economic development initiatives;
 - 5) Managing all Township shared services agreements;
 - 6) Managing Township public relations, including social media; and
 - 7) Serving as Joint Insurance Fund and Health Insurance Fund Commissioner.

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Legislature adopted, and the Governor signed, P.L. 2013, Chapter 159, which amended the Redevelopment Law, including the procedural requirements of N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-5 and N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-6; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-6, "[t]he resolution authorizing the Planning Board to undertake a preliminary investigation shall state whether the redevelopment area determination shall authorize the municipality to use all those powers provided by the Legislature for use in a redevelopment area other than the use of eminent domain (hereinafter referred to as a "Non-Condemnation Redevelopment Area") or whether the redevelopment area determination shall authorize the municipality to use all those powers provided by the Legislature for use in a redevelopment area, including the power of eminent domain (hereinafter referred to as a "Condemnation Redevelopment Area"); and

WHEREAS, the Township Council finds it to be in the best interest of the Township and its residents to authorize the Township's Planning Board pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-4 and N.J.S.A. 40A:12A-6 to undertake such preliminary investigation of the Study Area as a Condemnation Redevelopment Area, which Study Area is property located at Block 6404, Lot 7, commonly known as 299-301 Marshall Hill Road, and the 13.557 acre portion of 6002, Lot 18.01 that is not included in the Township's Recreation and Open Space Inventory, commonly known as the southwest corner of Marshall Hill Road and Airport Road; and
